

Easter Elementary School: Permissions and Safety Information (2026)

By booking a place at Easter Elementary School, you confirm you are the parent/guardian of the student and you give permission for your child to participate in supervised programme activities, which include rehearsals and group music sessions, a final performance, and supervised breaks and activities.

Public livestream and recording (required to participate)

The final performance is live streamed publicly on Facebook via School of Popular Music's Facebook page. The live video may remain available to watch afterwards on the page. Students may be identifiable by image and/or voice. Student surnames are not shared. Comments are moderated. Please note that once content is public online, School of Popular Music cannot fully control copying, sharing, or re-posting by third parties.

Off-site activity: Easter Egg Hunt

The Easter Egg Hunt takes place at Delancey Park, St Sampson (or a nearby alternative if required for safety or weather). Appropriate supervision will be provided. Any major location changes will be communicated.

Marketing media (optional)

Separate from the public livestream above, School of Popular Music may take photos/videos during the week for marketing (website, social media, print). Surnames are not used without separate permission. Your marketing preference is selected at sign-up and can be updated by contacting SOPM. If "No identifiable marketing use" is selected, SOPM will take reasonable steps to avoid use and to edit where practical.

Medical and emergency information

You are responsible for providing accurate allergy, medical, and additional needs information at sign-up and informing SOPM of any changes before the programme starts. An emergency contact must be available during programme hours.

Supervision and liability

School of Popular Music will provide appropriate supervision and take reasonable steps to keep activities safe. School of Popular Music and its staff are not liable for circumstances outside their reasonable control, except where caused by negligence.
